Proposed Restoration Project & Impact

The Fans of Valley Field and City of Grand Rapids are working with Integrated Architecture and Rockford Construction to finalize a comprehensive, community-informed plan to restore and enhance Sullivan Field. This project will include the following:

- The grandstand will receive a new roof, restored siding and bleachers, new protective netting, and upgraded sound system, while honoring and preserving its historic character
- The existing dugouts (which are not original to the site) will be demolished to eliminate obstructed views and new dugouts will be built with viewing decks above
- The playing surface will be leveled and resodded and the pitchers mound and batters box will be rebuilt
- Two bullpens and new batting cages will be constructed
- Locker rooms will be added under the grandstand
- The restrooms will be renovated to accommodate increased use
- The concessions and ticketing facility will be renovated to provide more opportunities for earned revenue
- A museum will be constructed that honors the history of the park
- A new, accessible grand entrance will be added to the corner of Valley Avenue and 6th Street
- A new plaza will be constructed to host concerts in the summer and an ice rink in the winter
- New landscaping will be added throughout the site
